Talking Points

Beware

Paris, it is a flat: we have judgy downstairs neighbours who will not hesitate to come up and confront us. Be mindful: no running, no yelling, no loud noises. Be extremely nice to the other residents, including the concierge. Nobody other than us will sleep there, so we can get up and go to bed whenever. Be careful in the house: we have many possessions. This flat is my family’s main hub, so our stuff is a bit everywhere. Two of you will also be sleeping in my childhood room: do not mess around with anything, please. The shower bathroom is a bit messed up, so beware of too much condensation and destroying the ceiling. **Warning:** the dining table in the lounge is extremely expensive and fragile. We are not allowed to place any bags on it and must be extremely gentle when using things on it.

In St-Tropez, the house will have my grandmother **Dolly** and her “partner” **Jean-Luc**. You had better be extremely nice to my grandmother. She is an elderly woman: be kind. You are expected to help her whenever you think you can. She has two dogs: a Jack Russell called **Mathilda** and a Chihuahua called **Timale** (the Chihuahua is dangerous: it pisses everywhere, so beware: don’t say this to my grandmother). These dogs are her life; she is more concerned about them than anything else in the world. If she sees one of you mistreat or be inconsiderate around them she will kick you out of the property: this is not a joke; it has happened before.

The house has two large metal gates and a side door to enter and exit; these are to be closed at all times: the dogs will try to escape. If even one of you screws up and forgets to close it or opens it without locking the dogs up inside, not only will a dog definitely escape, we will all get set on the street. We will also be called to round them up and close all the doors and windows on some occasions, such as when we have visitors or at nightfall: we will go around the house, close everything up, then make sure both dogs are inside.

Because this house will also have two residents during our stay: be quiet at night, in the morning, and in the afternoon (she takes naps). Offer some help with cleaning or cooking if we ever all eat together. We will also buy my grandmother some snacks and flowers on our first day in St-Tropez.

Lastly, you are **not** to bring or consume alcohol in the flat. Do what you will outside, but not in my house. In St-Tropez I guess it would be fine, but only in the evening and upstairs.

Fun part

The flat in Paris has two bedrooms: my parents’ and my childhood rooms. Parents’ has a king-size bed; childhood has two small singles. My childhood room is pretty small and jam-packed with stuff, so there isn’t much space to move around the beds. We also have a nice couch in the lounge. The kitchen has an eating bar in addition to that dining table I mentioned. There is a bathroom next to the rooms with a shower, and a toilet near the entrance (but it’s a bit tricky: some special way to flush it).

To enter the building, the first door has a code of “**2378B.**” Inside the entrance, there is a second door on the right with a keypad; you’ll need to use the arrows to scroll to the name **Beliard** and press dial. I will buzz you in from upstairs.

The house in St-Tropez is built on two separate floors. The main parts of the house are downstairs, where my grandmother sleeps and where the lounge is. The upstairs will be dedicated to our use, so we should restrict most of our time there: it has two full bedrooms with king-size beds, two bathrooms, and a kitchen. There is an additional room on the downstairs level that is aside, and a cabana that my grandmother cleared out for us (it’s from Bali!). The house also has a massive garden along with a swimming pool that we may enjoy.
